	4 fine tip black dry erase markers (we often use markers in guided groups and games)
	1 plastic ruler
	1 large pencil case that can hold pencils, markers, etc.
	2 small pencil sharpeners (enclosed shavings, one will usually break throughout the year.)
	6 white erasers
	2 packages of fine tip Crayola markers
	1 pack of regular wide tip Crayola markers
	1 good pair of headphones, not Dollarama as they break easily
	1 pair of good quality scissors
	4 <u>large</u> glue sticks - UHU or Elmer's (no disappearing purple)
	1 small bottle of liquid white glue – ELMER'S
	1 pkg of loose leaf
	1 large (approx. 10x10) Ziploc bag
	2 boxes of Kleenex
	 10 plastic duotangs with 3 holes, preferably with pouches (1 yellow, 1 green, 1 light blue,1 white/grey, red, 1 orange, 1 dark/navy blue, 1 purple, 2 black. It's important to have these specific colours to identify one as science, another as spelling, etc., Walmart or Staples should have them) Please don't buy paper duotangs as they rip easily
